Funding for these enhanced learning programs on the federal level, which has been rapidly rising, comes from such sources as the After School 21st Century Community Learning Centers initiative which provides \$1.2B annually. In addition to federal sources there is funding coming from state and local initiatives, foundations and faith based organizations.

The Quadrant 4 delegation joining the panel include Ms. Mary N. Watson, former director of Exceptional Children for the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction, Dr. Morgan C.
